

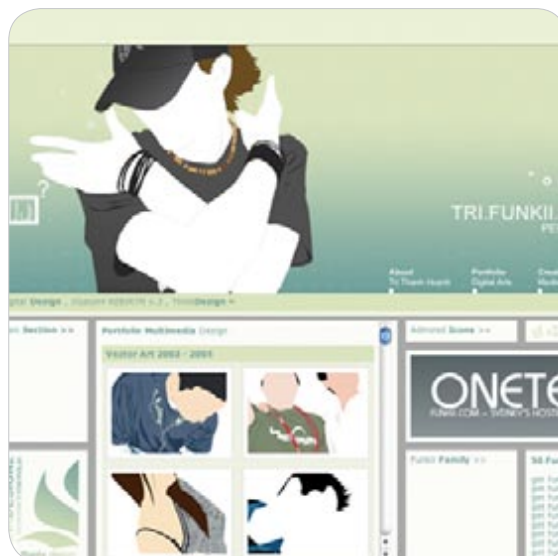
CUF30107 Certificate III in Media - VET in Schools Program

Get a head start in creative digital media

High school students in year 10 or above can enrol in the Certificate III in Media under the Qantm VET in Schools program. The course runs over two years part-time (or one year full-time) and offers two areas of specialisation: **Screen & Media** and **Interactive Digital Media**. Upon successful completion students will achieve a nationally recognised qualification and fundamental industry skills.

The course has been broken up into four semesters to suit normal school calendars, with each period of study being paid at the start of the semester.

Interactive Digital Media covers a wider range of skills including: graphic design/image manipulation, 2D animation, interactive content management as well as visual and audio editing.
