

School-based Traineeships in Media

School-based traineeships allow Queensland secondary school students - typically Years 11 and 12 – to work with an employer as paid employees while still at school. Throughout the traineeship, students gain knowledge and skills in their chosen media industry. On successful completion the trainee will be awarded a Certificate III in Media.

The CUF30107 Certificate III in Media is a nationally recognised qualification with potential credit towards the trainee's QCE (Queensland Certificate of Education).

Benefits for school-based trainees

- Government incentives and allowances are available to help cover the costs involved of employing a trainee
- hands-on experience and the opportunity to apply developing skills in a real job
- being a step ahead of the competition for jobs
- students get paid while they learn
- a great transition from school to work

- qualifications can also provide pathways to tertiary study through articulation to higher level courses.

The CUF30107 Certificate III in Media

The Certificate III in Media is considered a core qualification that provides trainees with a solid foundation in a number of key media areas within the media industries. Some relevant theoretical knowledge and social aspects associated with the industry are also explored.

Skills developed in the Certificate III in Media can include:

- visual design
- 2D animation
- digital photography
- digital video and audio editing
- interactive sequences
- website maintenance
- 3D modelling and animation
- digital video production

Overview of the CUF30107 Certificate III in Media Traineeship

- The school-based traineeship is undertaken over a two year period.
- The training is delivered online, allowing flexibility to study and work
- Regular feedback is provided to support the trainee throughout their traineeship
- Block training sessions are offered during school holiday periods to enable trainees to fast track their traineeship, participate in workshops and gain assistance from Qantm instructors.
- lab access is available at Qantm College Brisbane Campus.
- Site visits to the trainee's workplace to assist trainees to meet their training plan.
