Principles of Design

This unit explores all aspects of the design process including identifying the essential elements for successful design, the importance of visual communication and a detailed look at the design theory, key principles of achieving the successful design. It further explores design history and its impact on culture and society, today's design theory and how technology has affected current thinking and emerging trends and directions for future design.

2D Graphics (Photoshop)

This is an intensive course that will take students to an intermediate level in 2D graphics using Adobe Photoshop. Students will develop a range of skills that will enable them to create and manipulate digital images as a response to a brief. On completion of the assessment and extension activities provided, students will be capable of applying these skills to their own creative outcomes.

Develop and Update Web Pages

This is an intensive course that will take students to an intermediate level in web development with the ability to build and update static web sites that meet international standards (W3C compliant). During this course students will learn basic HTML & CSS to develop and update websites.

The software demonstrated in this course is Adobe Dreamweaver. Some experience in Adobe Photoshop or similar graphics program is required.

2D Animation (Flash)

This is an intensive course that will take students to an intermediate level in 2D animation using Adobe Flash. Students will develop a range of skills that will enable them to create a 2D animation as a response to a brief including storyboards. On completion of the assessment and extension activities provided, students will be capable of applying these skills to their own creative outcomes.

The software demonstrated in this course is Adobe Flash. Some experience in Adobe Photoshop or similar graphics program is required.

Web Design & Development

This is an intensive course that will take students to an intermediate level in web development. Students will develop a set of skills to enable them to write content for the web and use the principles of visual design to effectively plan the navigation and interface in order to build a static web site. This website will be built to meet international standards (W3C compliant) in response to a brief. On completion of the assessment provided, students will be capable of applying these skills to their own creative outcomes.

The software demonstrated in this course is Adobe Dreamweaver. Some prior experience in Adobe Photoshop or similar graphics program is required.

3D Modelling and Animation

This short course explores the fundamentals of 3D with an overview of simple modelling and texturing, polygon modelling and character creation. It also looks at the principles of animation and relates them to the latest modelling techniques for 3D character rigging, facial animation, lip-sync and dialogue driven character animation. Virtual environments are studied with lighting, digital texturing, painting and composition. A history of 3D modelling together with a look at animation in the multimedia, film and games industries completes this short course.

The software demonstrated in this course is student's choice of 3D Studio Max or Maya.

Digital Audio Editing

This short course explores aspects of working with digital audio. It examines how audio and video are utilized in the interactive entertainment sector in areas such as narrative, soundtracks, effects and atmospherics. The units cover audio sampling/recording and engineering, basic sound editing and final sound balance.

Digital Video Editing

This short course explores various aspects of working with digital video. It examines how audio and video are utilized in the interactive entertainment sector in areas such as narrative, soundtracks, effects and atmospherics. The units explore video production, file formats, camera techniques, capturing and resource management plus logging video footage & material, basic video editing & basic special effects and titling.

The software demonstrated in this course is student's choice of Adobe Premiere Pro or Final Cut Pro.

Basic Digital Audio & Video

This short course explores aspects of working with digital audio/video. It examines how audio and video are utilized in the interactive entertainment sector in areas such as narrative, soundtracks, effects and atmospherics. The audio side covers editing, sampling/recording and engineering, while the video element explores production, file formats, camera techniques, capturing and resource management plus basic video editing.
