3D Animation

Basic 3d Studio Max (SC204)

Learn the basics of 3ds Max (version 2009 or better required). Covers creating models, texturing and lighting, and various animation techniques.

Requires no prior knowledge of 3ds Max, but general computer literacy and some knowledge of photoshop would be advantageous.

This short course incorporates the units CUFANM303A Create 3D digital models and CUFANM302A Create 3D digital animations. These units are part of the course CUF30107 Certificate III in Media, and are also pre-requisites for the course CUF50207 Diploma of Screen and Media (Animation) offered at Qantm College.*

This short course incorporates the units CUFANM501A Create 3D digital character animation, CUFANM502A Create 3D digital environments and CUFANM402A Prepare 3D models for production. These units are part of the course CUF50107 Diploma of Screen and Media (Animation).
